This center has been developed out of the need to cater for young people between the age of 15 – 19 who find it difficult to attend traditional secondary school education.

Wodonga Senior Secondary College has been running a successful Flexible Learning Centre for 5 years and so were happy to assist Benalla and drive the management of the program.

This is a great opportunity for our town and our young people to engage in an educational program that is tailored to their needs, and aspirations. Each student will have a varied timetable and will work closely with one teacher in a small group or even one on one if and when required.

There will be close links with the community and support agencies will also be engaged to ensure the best outcomes for our students.

While at Benalla Flexible Learning Centre students will be working toward Certificate 11 in General Education for Adults. This includes literacy, numeracy and a community involvement project. As you can imagine the process of creating a new school has many challenges. One of these is that we cannot begin classes until the building has been checked and approved for student use by a quality assurance team. Hopefully this will occur over the next week. In addition to this the tables and chairs currently in the room will be returned to their owners and we will be ordering new furniture for the room.

In the meantime students will be expected to attend school to develop their individual learning plan and timetable.
