# HAVE YOU COLLECTED YOUR VACCINATION CARDS?

#### PLEASE REMEMBER TO RETURN THESE TO SCHOOL BY MONDAY JUNE 1

Vaccinations are an extremely important aspect of keeping ourselves healthy. Many of our students may have missed important vaccinations while they were at main stream school.

We have organised for immunisations to take place for free at the school on June 22 at 2 pm.

Many of us don't remember what vaccinations we have had so the administrators are assisting us with the process. The records will be checked and if vaccinations are required they will organise the correct vaccine to be administered on the 22 June.

Email received from immunisation co-ordinator below:

We would offer all of the 3 Year 7 vaccines (chicken pox, Boostrix (Diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough) and HPV) to all students Year 8 -12. This would be done by disseminating consent cards for all 3 vaccines to all students - once we have received the signed consent cards we would double check our records and the HPV register to determine if the vaccine is still required.
