CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND

Financial Assistance Information for Parents

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund will ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities.

School **camps** provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, **excursions** encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and **sports** teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF will be provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance will be paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions, or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student will be:

\$225 for secondary school students.

How to Apply— please make sure you have seen Anna, Michele or Sean to complete the application form. It takes no time at all to fill out the form.

Alternatively you can ring the school to notify them of your health care card or pension number and we will fill out the form for you.

It is important that this is done by the end of term so that the claim can be processed.

OUR SCHOOL IS GROWING

As the number of enrolments continue to grow we must ensure that we maintain the welcoming environment in our classroom. At Benalla Flexible Learning Centre we are committed to offering students individual programs with support from a supportive teacher. For us to continue to support students in this manner we are asking that students book their minimum of three sessions with their teacher into a permanent slot on the weekly timetable.

This is needed for a number of reasons:

- 1. To ensure that the classroom does not become overcrowded at any one time.
- 2. To ensure that Anna, Sean or Michele are available to help you when you arrive at school.
- 3. Enable us to group students into small groups that work well together.
- 4. Ensure that resources, such as computers will be available for your use if required.
- 5. Enable staff to plan and be organised for your lesson.
- 6. To ensure that Anna and Sean can have a break during the day. At the moment they are working from 8am till often 5pm without a break.

Please talk to your teacher next week to 'lock in' your preferred time and day of attendance. This arrangement does not mean that these are the only times you are able to attend school, but they will be the time you are expected to be at school for an intensive session with your teacher. Attendance is recorded for these sessions.
