Social enterprise is an opportunity for students to engage in all elements of a starting a business. This voluntary programme allows students to learn work related skills and build their resume as they investigate a variety of career options. In a safe and supportive environment students engage in planning, building and problem-solving in applying business skills to the real world.

Students learn the importance of various work skills, and gain real life experiences through participating in making a business that raises funds for local non-for-profit organisations.

Students not only source funds to start their business ideas, but implement their concepts to achieve learning outcomes for their schooling. Students learn the do's and don'ts of work life in a stress free context .

Organisations that have benefited so far have been; Tomorrow Today, Live4Life and the Molyullah Easter Sports. The AOK Businesses ran by Benalla Flexible Learning Centre have their programs approved through the Social Enterprise Group which allocates funds, identifies areas for improvement and selects the organisations that that groups will contribute to.

The sky is the limit as students test their work readiness in the world and evaluate their success to plan for the future.

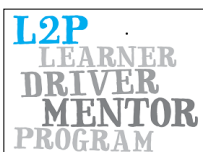
AOK businesses that are currently in operation include: TinyHouse Project, Bike Repair and Restoration, AOK Coffee, AOK Gallery.

Are you 16 and wanting to obtain your Learners Permit? Speak to your teacher, BFLC can help you prepare and learn the road rules.

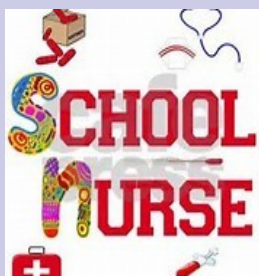
Once you have your L's you can then join the L2P programme operating every Tuesday here at BFLC.
