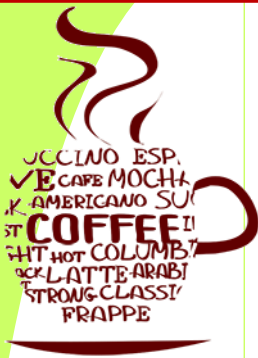


The students of Benalla FLC continue to be extremely grateful for these kind donations. They look forward to showcasing their talents through this new equipment.

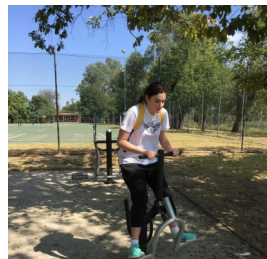

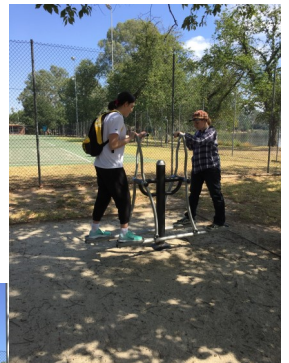

Lake Walk

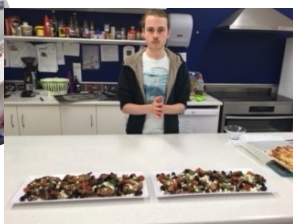


Students and staff enjoying the local surrounds with a walk around the lake. They utilised the facilities that Benalla has to offer, on a beautiful Autumn day.



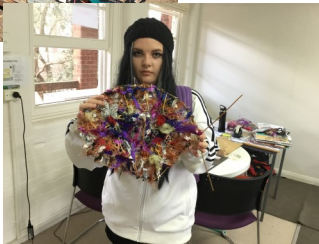
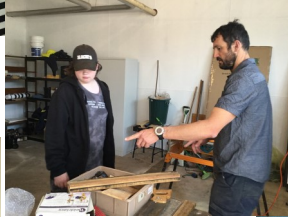
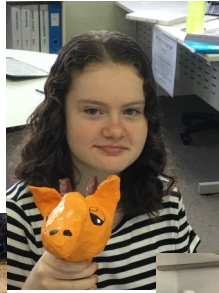
VCAL Literacy - Understanding, following and using procedural texts to achieve a goal and purpose
