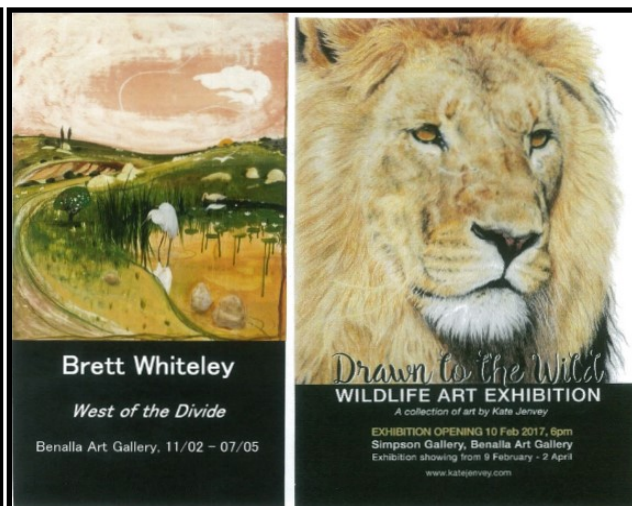
Benalla Gallery
