Thanks to a Tomorrow:Today Community Grant provided to North East Artisans students at Benalla Flexible Learning Centre last week were involved in working with artist Edie Black to create a fantastic street art mural on the toilet block wall.



From a blank wall on Monday morning students worked enthusiastically to mask out and paint the background for the scene to be created. By the end of day one the background was finished with the stencils being created by students for the foreground decorations. Thursday and Friday saw the students adding their stencilled shapes to the building, with the final touches occurring on Friday and the main tree and couch added to the scene.

This was a fantastic project that enabled all students to engage with the artist and complete sections of the mural as part of an ongoing project. 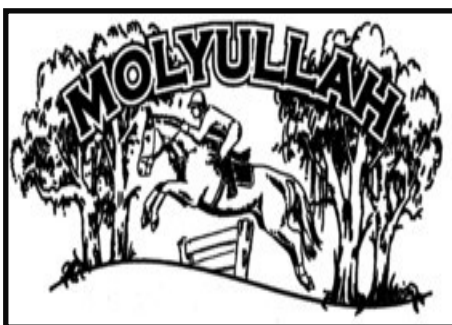
