If there is something causing concern and you don't feel you can say it face to face, then write it down and place it in the box.

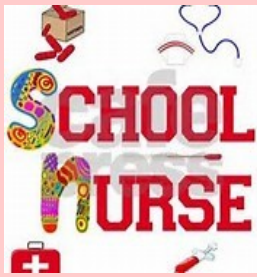
If you have something positive to say about school, a staff member or fellow student write it down and place in box.
